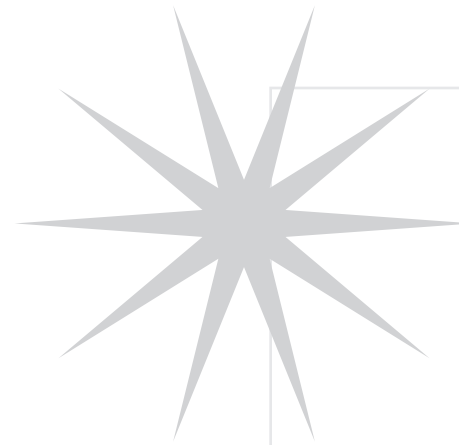

## MISSION STATEMENT

## Major

Three CIS programs offer majors: International Human Rights, International Studies, and the Self-Designed Interdisciplinary Major.

Within International Studies, students may choose an individualized emphasis or an emphasis in International Human Rights.

## Minor

A CIS minor requires a minimum of 18 credit hours of formal coursework completed at Webster University. The minor is formally acknowledged on the student's transcript.

The CIS offers minors in Ancient Studies, Environmental Studies, Fine Arts, International Human Rights, Latin American Studies, Liberal Arts, Multicultural Studies, and Women's Studies.

## Certificates

Undergraduate certificates provide students the opportunity to concentrate on a specific area of study. Students who wish to pursue a certificate program at Webster must apply and be accepted as degree-seeking. The certificate program is also open to individuals not currently enrolled who meet the general requirements for admission to the University. The certificate is formally acknowledged on the student's transcript.

The CIS offers certificates in International Human Rights, International Studies, Practical and Interdisciplinary Ethics, and Women's Studies.
