



ENDANGERED INSTRUMENT AWARD FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2022-2023
(Summer 2022, Fall 2022 & Spring 2023)

The Community Music School of Webster University offers a limited number of financial awards for **new** CMS pre-college students who wish to study *viola, double bass, oboe, bassoon, horn, trombone or tuba*. The award is available for individual/ Suzuki lessons, ensembles, or summer camps. The award can be granted during the Summer, Fall or Spring Semester.

Students receiving the award receive:

Individual/ Suzuki lessons: 50% off tuition cost for a 30-minute lesson (based on an 18-week semester.) Awarded students must audition for and, if accepted take part in an ensemble.

Orchestra/ Ensembles: 50% off tuition cost for the 20-21 season. (Fall and Spring semester tuition). Students are not required to take individual lessons to receive the award for a CMS ensemble.

Summer Camps: 50% of the tuition costs for an individual camp.
