



CAEP Annual Reporting Measures 2020 Report Pertaining to 2016-2017 Completers

Measure 3: Satisfaction of employers and employment milestones (Component 4.3 | A.4.1)

Graduates of Webster University’s initial certification and advanced programs from academic year 2016-2017 were surveyed in Spring 2020 regarding their employment milestones (i.e., retention and promotion/tenure).

50% of the respondents from the initial certification programs survey indicated they are employed full time in a P-12 school, while 67% of respondents from the advanced studies program survey indicated they are employed full time in a P-12 district and 33% are employed part time.

Initial Certification Programs

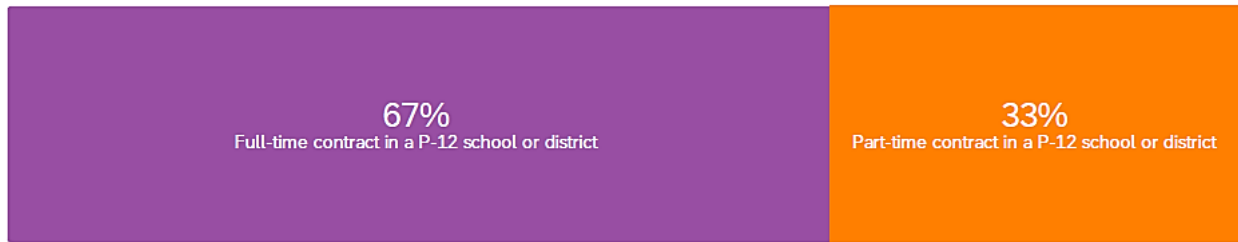

■ Full-time contract in a P-12 school or district (67%) ■ Part-time contract in a P-12 school or district (33%)

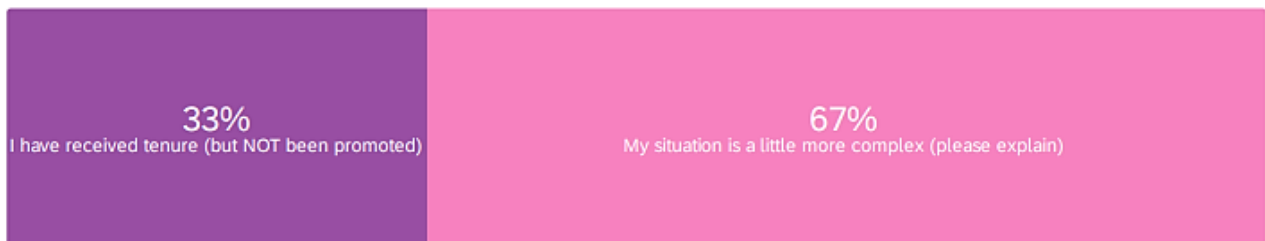
■ I am employed in a P-12 school, but in a different capacity (please describe your position and/or situation). (0%)

While none of the respondents from the initial certification programs survey indicated they have been tenured and/or received a promotion in the past three years, 33% of respondents from the advanced studies programs have received tenure but have not been promoted.
