- This plan assumes a student starting at Webster with no prior knowledge of French. If you have taken French in high school or have experience with the language outside of an academic setting, you should take the placement test so you can be placed at the most appropriate level and move more quickly into the advanced-level courses.
- This plan includes a study abroad semester in the spring of the third year. There are many options for international experiences (courses, internships) and diverse formats available (summer, semester, year). Depending on your

choice of program you may earn more than 5 credits and be able to move through the program more quickly or to add more easily a second major.

- This plan assumes that the student starts her/his university career at Webster. Transfer students can also complete a French degree but should either transfer French language from a previous institution, choose an intensive study abroad option, or be prepared to spend extra time at Webster in order to complete all the requirements.
- \*\*If you only take 5 advanced-French credits during a semester study abroad experience, you will need to request an independent study at some point during your advanced coursework. Please request this during registration period, so that you and the instructor can plan accordingly.
